



## COVID-19 Update – Still NO New Cases June 12, 2020

Dear Residents, Families, and Staff,

One more week has passed at Oak Hill without any positive cases of COVID-19. We currently have no residents showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

Testing is currently taking place for all staff members and residents of Oak Hill. As mandated by the Illinois Department of Public Health, this testing will be completed today (June 12<sup>th</sup>). The results of the facility-wide testing are scheduled to be returned on Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.

If any staff member's test is identified as Positive, they will be isolated at their homes immediately. Any identified Positive residents will be moved and quarantined in a specifically designated isolation area to contain the spread of the virus. If a resident of Magnolia Terrace tests Positive, they will remain isolated in their room for at least 14 days.

We are hoping and praying that all of the testing results come back as Negative. If so, we can begin to relax some of the restrictions that are currently in place for our residents' safety. Oak Hill residents could begin small group activities and utilize general common areas again. If all tests results are Negative, we would test all staff members again in two more weeks. If those results are also all Negative, Oak Hill can relax restrictions even further. After a third round of Negative test results, the plan is to begin allowing a small amount of visitors with health screens and face masks. As stated last week, if we have one resident or staff member test Positive, we will have to start at the beginning of this six-week process all over again.
