



**COVID-19 Update**  
**Currently No Positive Resident Cases**  
**August 14th, 2020**

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

After another round of testing, Oak Hill's residents remain COVID free. Our testing results were returned to us earlier this week, and we had one staff member test positive. They are asymptomatic, and are in active quarantine per the Department of Health guidelines. Once again, there were no residents who tested positive. We have tentatively planned to test again on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

The lack of transmission of the COVID virus to our residents is the sole responsibility of each and every employee here at Oak Hill. I would like to thank them all for being diligent with wearing their PPE (gloves, masks, gowns, etc.), and displaying appropriate hand-washing techniques/frequency. By their efforts, we have been able to protect our residents to this point. I am extremely proud of all the team-members here at Oak Hill.

Oak Hill continues to invite our families and loved ones for social-distancing visits. These will remain on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10am-noon and 1pm-3pm. Please call the main number and the receptionist will assist you with making an appointment. The weekly visitation schedule will be open for appointments each Friday around 10am. Please be considerate of there being a finite number of slots available. We would love for each resident to have the opportunity to receive a visit, before repeat appointments are scheduled. Below is a reminder of the guidelines that must be followed for each visit.

- All visits must be scheduled in advance with the facility.
- All visits must take place outside and be monitored by facility staff.
- 20/30-minute visits while maintaining a six-foot distance and no physical contact.
- Face masks must be worn at all times.
- Visitor screening must take place 24 hours prior to visiting and will be repeated on the day of the scheduled visit.
- No more than two visitors per resident are allowed to visit at the same time.
- No visitors under the age of 16 are allowed.

The safety and well-being of every resident at Oak Hill is our top priority. Thank you all, for your continued thoughts and prayers as we navigate this pandemic.
