Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill will be testing all staff again this Thursday 8-27. We continue to monitor each resident for signs and symptoms of the COVID Virus multiple times daily. As our surrounding communities see a major spike in cases, we remain extra vigilant in trying to keep it away from our residents. The Illinois Department of Public Health has informed us that we can maintain our outside visitation schedule for now. If or when that changes, I will be sure to let everyone know. Our visiting guidelines are below.

Oak Hill continues to invite our families and loved ones for social-distancing visits. These will remain on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10am-noon and 1pm-3pm. Please call the main number and the receptionist will assist you with making an appointment. As the outbreak continues throughout the region, the health and safety of all residents remain our greatest mission. Below is a reminder of the guidelines that must be followed for each visit. To this point, every visitor has complied with these regulations, and the visits have gone smoothly.

- All visits must be scheduled in advance with the facility.
- All visits must take place outside and be monitored by facility staff.
- 20/30 minute visits while maintaining a six-foot distance and no physical contact.
- Face masks must be worn at all times.
- Visitor screening must take place 24 hours prior to visiting, and will be repeated on the day of the scheduled visit.
- No more than two visitors per resident are allowed to visit at the same time.
- No visitors under the age of 16 are allowed.

As part of this wonderful community, I cannot stress enough how important it is to stay safe and healthy. Please do your part as you travel outside of your homes to help our community safely get through these difficult times.

The safety and well-being of every resident at Oak Hill is our top priority. Thank you all, for your continued thoughts and prayers as we navigate this pandemic.
