Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

COVID-19 has found its way into our facility. From yesterday's testing, we have been informed that 9 residents have tested positive so far. We are awaiting the entirety of the results, but have already enacted our COVID plan for quarantine. This immediate response is to limit any further spread of the virus within the facility. Of the residents who have tested positive, they all live on the same hall and are grouped together. We have quarantined the entire hall as a precaution.

As a result of our current status, all outside visits are cancelled until further notice. Please maintain contact with your loved one through phone calls and window visits.

Another symptom of quarantining is that the facility will not be able to admit any new residents until we have been successfully rid the building of this virus.

As part of this wonderful community, I cannot stress enough how important it is to stay safe and healthy. Please do your part as you travel outside of your homes to help our community safely get through these difficult times.
