Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

COVID-19 continues to be active within our facility. There have been a total of 15 residents test positive to this point. We had tested all residents and staff again yesterday (Thursday), and are awaiting the results. Oak Hill has enacted the COVID-19 plan for quarantine and are utilizing the COVID Unit for all positive residents and those who have been exposed. This response is to limit any further spread of the virus within the facility.

As a result of our current status, all outside visits are cancelled until further notice. Please maintain contact with your loved one through phone calls and window visits. It is extremely important to keep the windows closed during any window visit.

Another symptom of quarantining is that the facility will not be able to admit any new residents until we have successfully rid the building of this virus.

As part of this wonderful community, I cannot stress enough how important it is to stay safe and healthy. Please do your part as you travel outside of your homes to help our community safely get through these difficult times.

The safety and well-being of every resident at Oak Hill is our top priority. Thank you all, for your continued thoughts and prayers as we navigate this pandemic.
