Oak Hill is pleased to announce that we no-longer have any active cases of COVID-19 in the facility!

Oak Hill tested all employees and residents again on Monday (11-23) and we just received those results this afternoon. NO RESIDENTS OR STAFF MEMBERS TESTED POSITIVE!! We are hoping and praying that this trend continues. Oak Hill will be testing again on Monday (11-30). After two-weeks of testing without a positive resident or staff member, we can technically be removed from "Outbreak Status".

Oak Hill is also pleased to announce that we are opening our "Visitation Station" this week. Please be patient as we work on-the-fly to make sure this new visiting arrangement goes smoothly. To start, please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. We ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit. We would also like to hear suggestions on how we can improve on this visiting experience.

The overall numbers for the State of Illinois and the County of Monroe have shown a significant increase in COVID-19 cases. As of writing this, our county positivity rate is at 18.3%. Anything over 8% is considered high. As we gather with family and friends during this time, please be safe.

The threat of COVID now lies outside our front door, and no longer within our walls. For that, we are Thankful. Please do your part to keep yourself, your loved ones, and your community safe. Thank you all, for your continued support, thoughts and prayers as we navigate this pandemic.
