COVID-19 Update
January 14th, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill has received the results from our COVID-19 testing from Monday (1-11). No Residents tested positive! We did, however, have two staff members test positive. We tested all of the residents again today (1-14). There were no more positive residents identified. We will be able to remove the COVID Unit tomorrow and move most of the displaced residents back into their original rooms. As of tomorrow (1-15) we will not have any positive cases of COVID among the residents. We still have 6 staff members quarantined with the virus.

On a much brighter note, Oak Hill began their vaccination process last week (1-7). Between the residents and the staff, more than 230 vaccines were given. There were no major negative reactions to the vaccinations, and the process went very smooth. The next scheduled date for the second stage of the vaccine will be on Jan. 28th. If your loved one was not able to receive the first dose, they will be able to receive it on the 28th with their final dose being administered on Feb 18th. We want to make certain that every resident has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. This is a very big "First Step" toward starting the process of being able to relax some of the mitigation rules that we are currently having to abide by.

Oak Hill continues to utilize their "Visitation Station". Please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. It may also be helpful to call your loved one or the nurse's station prior to your visit to remind them to be ready. We also ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit.

We hope this New Year brings with it the tidings of health, and we can remember 2021 for being the year that we returned to "normal". We also wanted to thank Walgreens for their efforts in bringing the vaccine into our community.
