COVID-19 Update
January 22nd, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill has received the results from our COVID-19 testing from Monday (1-18). There was one resident in the Skilled Nursing area that tested positive and six residents on the Magnolia Terrace side that tested positive. These are the first positive residents from Magnolia Terrace since the pandemic started. There were also two more staff members that also tested positive. We re-tested all of the residents again on Thursday (1-21) and did not have any new positive results. We will be testing all residents and staff again on Monday (1-25).

On a much brighter note, Oak Hill will continue the vaccination process on Thursday of next week (1-21). Between the residents and the staff, more than 230 vaccines were given during the first round of vaccinations. On Thursday, the residents and staff will receive their second dose, or be offered the initial dose for those that either missed or declined the first time around. We want to make certain that every resident and staff member has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. The third and final scheduled date for the vaccine will be on February 18th. This is a very big "First Step" toward starting the process of being able to relax some of the mitigation rules that we are currently having to abide by.

Oak Hill continues to utilize their "Visitation Station". Please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. It may also be helpful to call your loved one or the nurse's station prior to your visit to remind them to be ready. We also ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit.

We hope this New Year brings with it the tidings of health, and we can remember 2021 for being the year that we returned to "normal". We also wanted to thank Walgreens for their efforts in bringing the vaccine into our community. Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions.
