COVID-19 Update
January 8th, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill has received the results from our COVID-19 testing from Monday (1-4). We had five more residents and one more staff member test positive. In light of the positive test results, we tested all of the residents again yesterday (1-7). From yesterday's testing, there were no more positive residents identified. For the individuals that have tested positive, their symptoms appear to be very mild. We will be testing again next Monday (1-11). There are currently 8 total positive residents in the facility and 4 current employees that are quarantined due to the virus.

On a much brighter note, Oak Hill began their vaccination process yesterday (1-7). Between the residents and the staff, more than 230 vaccines were given. There were no major negative reactions to the vaccinations, and the process went very smooth. The next scheduled date for the second stage of the vaccine will be on Jan. 28th. If your loved one was not able to receive the first dose, they will be able to receive it on the 28th with their final dose being administered on Feb 18th. We want to make certain that every resident has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. This is a very big "First Step" toward starting the process of being able to relax some of the mitigation rules that we are currently having to abide by.

Oak Hill continues to utilize their "Visitation Station". Please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. It may also be helpful to call your loved one or the nurse's station prior to your visit to remind them to be ready. We also ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit.

We hope this New Year brings with it the tidings of health, and we can remember 2021 for being the year that we returned to "normal". We also wanted to thank Walgreens for their efforts in bringing the vaccine into our community.
