COVID-19 Update
February 18th, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill has received the results from our COVID-19 testing from Monday (2-15). There were ZERO residents that tested positive. This includes the Magnolia Terrace side as well. There were two staff members that tested positive. We tested all of the residents again this morning (2-18) and received no more positive results. As of today, there are no active positive COVID-19 resident cases in the facility, and there is no longer an active COVID Unit being utilized in the facility. We are hoping this trend continues, so we could possibly relax some of the mitigation rules that we have been mandated to follow.

To continue the good news... Oak Hill continues the vaccination process today (2-18). This will be the third and final scheduled vaccine clinic hosted at Oak Hill. *96% of our residents have been vaccinated, and 68% of the staff have been vaccinated.* Oak Hill wants to make certain that every resident and staff member has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. Since this is the final scheduled vaccine clinic day, we have been working with Walgreen's to be able to offer the vaccine to any new admissions and new employees. They have been very accommodating and have assured us that they will have available doses on-hand for our residents. This is a very big "First Step" toward starting the process of being able to relax some of the mitigation rules that we are currently having to abide by.

Oak Hill continues to utilize their "Visitation Station". Please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. It may also be helpful to call your loved one or the nurse's station prior to your visit to remind them to be ready. We also ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit.
