



## **COVID-19 Update**

### **March 2nd, 2021**

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill has received the results from our COVID-19 testing from Monday (3-1). All residents and staff tested negative! This marks two consecutive weeks of testing negative throughout the Oak Hill Campus. This officially brings Oak Hill out of “Outbreak” status. We will plan to move into Phase 2 next week. This phase includes 25% occupancy in dining rooms and increased frequency of facility activity programming. As of yet, there are no plans to change the rules regarding family visitation. We have reached-out to IDPH and the CDC to see if they would be willing to revise the rules prohibiting family visits. We will be sure to keep everyone informed if/when changes to this rule are made.

To continue the good news... Oak Hill completed all three of their vaccination clinics. We have 98% of our residents vaccinated and 70% of the staff have completed the second step of the vaccination. Oak Hill wants to make certain that every resident and staff member has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. Since there are no more scheduled vaccine clinics at Oak Hill, we have been working with Walgreen’s to be able to offer the vaccine to any new admissions and new employees. They have been very accommodating and have assured us that they will have available doses on-hand for our residents and staff.

Oak Hill continues to utilize their “Visitation Station”. Please call the receptionist to schedule a day and time for visiting. We will have blocks of 30-minute times from 10am to 7:30 pm. It may also be helpful to call your loved one or the nurse’s station prior to your visit to remind them to be ready. We also ask that you please wipe down the area with the cleaner provided after your visit. Further instructions will be given when you call to reserve a time/day for your visit.
