



COVID-19 Update

April 23rd, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

Oak Hill continues to be COVID-19 free. It has been longer than 90 days since we have had a positive test result from a resident. We did, however, have a staff member test positive last week. We will continue to test all residents and staff members on a monthly basis. The next scheduled testing date is May 17th.

To continue the good news... Oak Hill completed all three of their vaccination clinics. We have 98% of our residents vaccinated and 70% of the staff have completed the second step of the vaccination. Oak Hill wants to make certain that every resident and staff member has the opportunity to receive the vaccination. Since there are no more scheduled vaccine clinics at Oak Hill, we have been working with Walgreen's and the local Health Department to be able to offer the vaccine to any new admissions and new employees. They have been very accommodating and have assured us that they will have available doses on-hand for our residents and staff.

Since the County COVID-19 Positivity Rate is below 5%, Oak Hill has been granted permission to slowly begin the re-opening process. We will be starting in-person visits this week. The process and rules are as follows:

- Visits will be scheduled between 10am and 4pm Monday through Friday.
- There can be up to 2 visitors per resident at a time.
- Visits are scheduled to last 45-50 minutes.
- Visits must take place in the common areas near the front lobby.
- Unless specified otherwise, there will be no visitors allowed down the hallways into the resident living areas.
- Masks need to be worn during the visits
- Social Distancing IS NOT REQUIRED during your visit. Please touch, hug and provide personal contact!
