



COVID-19 Update September 24, 2021

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

A vaccinated employee tested positive for COVID on Monday, September 20. This individual worked in the Arbor Court section of Oak Hill. As a precaution, all staff and residents were tested in the skilled nursing portion of the building on Monday, September 20 and Thursday, September 23.

We are pleased to announce that at this time no others tested positive for COVID.

As a precaution, all residents ate meals in their rooms until Thursday after testing of residents was completed that day and verification was received that there were no other positive cases. With these test results, the dining room was reopened Thursday afternoon.

Visitation may resume on Whispering Pines and Evergreen Pointe since the affected employee did not work in these areas. Visitation for Arbor Court is limited to the partitioned visiting area near Gracie's garden. Visitation can be scheduled through the receptionist. Activities on Arbor Court have been modified and there will be no group activities until October 4, if there are no positive cases. Visitation will resume for Arbor Court on October 4 if there are no new COVID cases. Magnolia Terrace has not been affected.

Additionally, Oak Hill would like to share that Kim Keckritz is serving as Interim Administrator upon the resignation of Brian Koontz. Kim had previously served as the Administrator from 2001-2020 and will serve in this roll until a replacement can be found. .
