



COVID-19 Update

December 27, 2021

Dear Residents and Families,

We have had several employees and three residents who have tested positive for COVID. Testing of residents and all staff for COVID has started today, December 27th. Testing will be completed every Monday and Thursday for the next two weeks. Additional testing past this time will be required if we do not receive 100% negative results. In addition to testing, we have also increased monitoring of residents for symptoms.

While visiting is not prohibited during this time, we do ask that you carefully consider the risk of visiting. It is safer at this time for you not to enter Oak Hill. We are not only worried about your safety but of course the safety of our residents. With the positivity rate in the area so high, it is possible that you unknowingly are carrying the virus. We are finding positive cases in those that are fully vaccinated and those who have had the booster shot. The symptoms are mild, and you may disregard them as allergies or a cold. If you do decide to visit, you must wear a well-fitting mask at all times, and we ask that you frequently wash or sanitize your hands and socially distance. We encourage you to be tested before coming to Oak Hill.

We are working hard to control the spread of the virus. Your support and understanding are appreciated at this time. Most of all, we need your help to provide safe visiting by limiting visits, using precautions, and only visiting when you have no symptoms.
