Dear Residents, Staff and Families,

I am happy to inform you that there were no new positive cases of residents during our last testing on Thursday, January 21. We do currently have staff that are positive who are home isolating.

We are continuing to closely follow the guidelines from the State of Illinois to keep our residents as safe as possible. One of the clarifications of the new guidance includes the following important information regarding visitors.

- ***IF YOU HAVE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID, YOU MUST WAIT AT LEAST 10 DAYS AFTER YOU TESTED POSITIVE TO RETURN TO VISIT AT OAK HILL***
- ***IF YOU HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH A COVID POSITIVE INDIVIDUAL, YOU MUST ISOLATE AND MAY NOT VISIT AT OAK HILL FOR 14 DAYS***
- ***THESE GUIDELINES APPLY REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS***
- ***IDPH ALSO RECOMMENDS THAT YOU WEAR A SURGICAL MASK OR KN95***
